The Stuller is responsible for assisting with coating and lining machines, hand blasting, hand patching, cleaning pipe, and mixing paint.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Helps unloads materials and equipment safely and efficiently.
- Helps move product, materials and equipment safely.
- Prepares vehicles and equipment for loads.
- Mixes cement and prepares material for patch work.
- Performs cement labor as needed by lead person and supervisor.
- Cuts materials in a safe manner to ensure safe transport of product and equipment
- Counts and marks all materials.
- Operates forklift in a safe manner.
- Participates in all inventories.
- Performs other duties as needed by the Shipping Supervisor.
- Conducts STOP audits.
- Ensures ISO procedures are performed correctly.
