JOB SUMMARY:

The Facilities Engineer directs and coordinates activities in spiral weld pipe manufacturing plant in processing materials and manufacturing products by performing the following duties personally or through subordinate supervisors. Manages staff for capital project planning and implementation.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Design and maintain manufacturing equipment.
- Plans production operations, establishing priorities and sequences for manufacturing products.
- Prepares operational schedules and coordinates manufacturing activities to ensure production and quality of products meets specifications.
- Reviews production and operating reports and resolves operational, manufacturing, and maintenance problems to ensure minimum costs and prevent operational delays.
- Develops or revises standard operational and working practices.
- Oversee capital projects field installations.
- Communicate with vendors and negotiate prices.
- Communicate up/down the organization.
- Generate estimates for individual equipment and processes.
- Solve technical and manufacturing problems.
- Promotes and develops safe operations within the Parkersburg facility.

SECONDARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The individual works within established guidelines with decision-making authority.
- Responsible for all aspects product manufacturing per approved drawings within set industry standards such as AWWA, ASME, and AWS.
- Responsible for plant maintenance staffing levels required to meet established production levels.
- Provides plant design solutions to meet industry standards such as OSHA, NEC, etc.
