### SUMMARY OF JOB PURPOSE:

Maintenance Mechanic installs, maintains, troubleshoots, and repairs facility machinery. Assists in the departmental housekeeping and safety efforts, orders parts required to maintain repair part inventories, and works collaboratively with equipment repair mechanics, production counterparts, and vendors to ensure production work flow.

### ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Follows all safety and company policies/procedures and promotes a safe culture
- Complies with all OSHA safety requirements, work rules and regulations
- Wear all required personal protective equipment
- Comply with and enforce lock out/tag out procedures
- Fluid Power (pumps, valves, and pneumatics, and seals) repair and maintenance
- Install facility machinery
- Perform corrective, preventative, and predictive maintenance on machinery
- Perform inspection of assigned equipment; replace or repair faulty parts and equipment
- Operate and troubleshoot diagnostic equipment
- Clean and lubricate parts
- Track and submit work done and productivity on a daily basis
- Effectively communicate issues to management

### SECONDARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Safely operate mobile machinery certified to use
- Research and order parts using purchasing protocols
- Maintain and secure work tools
- Clean shop and work areas
- Maintain/propose standard operating procedures (SOPs) and job safety analysis(JSAs)
- Other duties may be assigned as necessary

### JOB SCOPE:

- This position provides support to the Maintenance Department with a primary focus on maintenance on industrial equipment and machinery.

#### **KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES:**

- Knowledge of predictive maintenance protocols and tools
- Must have the ability to operate the following equipment: Hand tools, stationary equipment, vehicles
- Must be able to use precision measuring equipment
- Ability to read and interpret blueprints and schematics
- Ability to read and comprehend instructions and correspondence
- Reading gauges and watching guides
- Ability to problem solve, troubleshoot, multitask and work independently with attention to detail
- Ability to work against and meet deadlines
- Basic electrical understanding
- Basic math skills
- Experience as a machinist a plus
- Preference given to candidates with some industrial electrical background

#### **EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:**

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Certification and or Associates Degree preferred but not required
- Prefer a minimum two years as a maintenance mechanic in a heavy manufacturing environment

#### **CERTIFICATES, LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS:**

- None required

#### **WORK HOURS/SHIFT:**

- Work hours vary or change based on operational needs
- Must be able to work overtime as required

#### **PHYSICAL DEMANDS/WORK ENVIRONMENT:**

- The environmental conditions for this position include inclement outdoor extremes of cold, heat, dust, wind and various forms of precipitation.
- Walking, moving around and or standing eight (8) hours or more per day. Walking includes moving within an 80 acre facility with dirt roads and uneven ground.
- Recurring climbing and descending of stairs throughout the day to perform work at heights. Work for this position can be performed at an elevated station and requires a comfort with heights and balance.
- A minimum amount of sitting may be required for this position.
- There is repetitive hand-wrist, elbow and shoulder motion required for this position for approximately eight (8) hours during the work day.
- Lifting and or retrieving items of 0-50 pounds without assistance; 50–100 pounds with assistance and 100+ pounds with mechanical assistance.
- In the course of a normal day additional physical activities include bending, stooping, squatting, kneeling, crawling, pushing, pulling, twisting, reaching and climbing ladders.
- Employees in this position are exposed to a wide range of varying degree of moderate to excessive noise levels.
- Sight must be within normal ranges to determine that machines are running properly. Specific vision abilities also include close, distance, color, peripheral, depth and the ability to adjust and focus.

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
