**SUMMARY OF JOB PURPOSE:**

Performs basic fluid services and minor repairs, including preventive/predictive maintenance, on plant mobile equipment.

**ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Fuel all mobile equipment.
- Fill and top off vital fluids; lubricate and change filters on all mobile equipment.
- Perform minor repair on mobile equipment.
- Assist mobile mechanic as required.
- Maintain fueling and lubrication records.
- Maintain a filter supply.
- Repair or change tires.
- Perform other assigned duties.
- Ensure work space stays clean and safe for all.
- Follow all Lockout/Tagout procedures.
- Regular and reliable attendance is required.

**SECONDARY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Clean and lubricate fittings as needed.
- Replace car lights and wipers as needed.
- Ensure tire pressure is at the manufacture's recommendation and rotate tires as needed.
- Inspect vehicles when servicing and report concerns and issues to mobile mechanic, lead person, foreman or supervisor.
- Other duties as assigned.

**KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES:**

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skills and/or abilities required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, procedures and vehicle shop manuals.
- Requires basic mechanical knowledge.
- Ability to drive mobile equipment.
- Ability to write routine reports and maintain records.
- Ability to communicate effectively with coworkers, lead/foremen, supervisors and managers.
- Ability to add, subtract, multiply, and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions, and decimals.
- Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out detailed but uninvolved written or oral instructions.
- Ability to deal with problems involving a few concrete variables in standardized situations.

**EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:**



- High school diploma or general education degree (GED); or one to three months related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

**CERTIFICATES, LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS:**

- Forklift certification or ability to obtain upon employment.
- Ability to certify on Grader/Loader and other various industrial powered vehicles.
- Overhead Crane certification or ability to obtain upon employment.

**WORK HOURS / SHIFT:**

- Work hours vary or change based on operational needs.
- Must be able to work overtime as required.

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS/WORK ENVIRONMENT:**

- The employee frequently is required to walk, bend, stoop, squat, kneel, crouch, crawl, push, pull, twist and reach.
- Walking, moving around and or standing 6-8 hours or more per day. Walking includes moving within an 80-acre facility with dirt roads and uneven ground.
- Use hands to touch, reach with hands and arms, talk and hear.
- There is repetitive hand-wrist, elbow and shoulder motion required for this position for approximately 6-8 hours during the workday.
- The employee is occasionally required to sit, climb or balance, and use sensory abilities/skills to look, listen and smell.
- The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 10 pounds, frequently lift and/or move up to 25 pounds, occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds, move 50 – 100 pounds with assistance and 100+ pounds with mechanical assistance.
- Sight must be within normal ranges to determine that machines are running properly. Specific vision abilities include close, distance, color, peripheral, depth and the ability to adjust and focus.
- Recurring climbing and descending of stairs throughout the day to perform work at heights.
- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to moving mechanical parts.
- Exposure to a wide range of varying degree of moderate to excessive noise levels.
- Work for this position can be performed at an elevated station and requires a comfort with heights and balance.
- The employee will be exposed to outside elements for 50% percent of a usual eight (8) hour shift: heat, cold, various forms of precipitation and dust.
