SUMMARY OF JOB PURPOSE:

Responsible for the safe and efficient execution of preparation and paint blasting of products as required.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Preparation of product surface, including masking, sanding, and visual inspection.
- Paint blast and coat products.
- Maintain productivity to ensure the timely delivery of material.
- Proper cleanup and waste disposal.
- Perform other work related tasks as assigned.

SECONDARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Be able to utilize basic hand tools and power tools.
- Be able work at heights over 10'
- Must be able to read & interpret precision Instruments
- Reports safety or equipment problems.
- Performs other assigned duties.
- Maintain sufficient knowledge of basic math.
- Complete required daily production report.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. - Ability to wear a respirator.
- Must be detailed oriented

 - Have prior experience operating large semi-automatic manufacturing equipment.

- Work hours vary or change based on operational needs.
- Must be able to work overtime as required.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS/WORK ENVIRONMENT:

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Project timelines and work volume / deadlines may often require working outside of standard hours, weekend or evening work, and travel to complete essential duties of this job.
- Ability to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral, or diagram form and to solve problems involving several variables.
- Walking, moving around and or standing 6-8 hours or more per day. Walking includes moving within an 80-acre facility with dirt roads and uneven ground.
- Use hands to touch, reach with hands and arms, talk and hear.
- There is repetitive hand-wrist, elbow and shoulder motion required for this position for approximately 6-8 hours during the workday.
- The employee is occasionally required to sit, climb or balance, and use sensory abilities/skills to look, listen and smell.
- The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 10 pounds, frequently lift and/or move up to 25 pounds, occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds, move 50 – 100 pounds with assistance and 100+ pounds with mechanical assistance.
- Sight must be within normal ranges to determine that machines are running properly. Specific vision abilities include close, distance, color, peripheral, depth and the ability to adjust and focus.
- Recurring climbing and descending of stairs throughout the day to perform work at heights.
- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to moving mechanical parts.
- Exposure to a wide range of varying degree of moderate to excessive noise levels.
- Work for this position can be performed at an elevated station and requires a comfort with heights and balance.
- The employee will be exposed to outside elements for 50% percent of a usual eight (8) hour shift: heat, cold, various forms of precipitation and dust.
- The employee is occasionally exposed to wet and/or humid conditions; high, precarious places; fumes or airborne particles; and toxic or caustic chemicals.
- **This job requires a specialized Pulmonary Function Test and related multi-page Questionnaire that is reviewed by a respiratory specialist.**
