JOB SUMMARY:

The QC Radiographer/Inspector shall demonstrate substantial knowledge of processes, codes, and job specifications and have the ability to perform routine QA/QC product inspections as required. The QC Inspector shall be knowledgeable in QA/QC equipment operations and associated documentation of inspections and testing.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Candidate will primarily be performing functions as a Level II Radiographer Technician and will be interpreting Radiographic Film in accordance with ASME and AWS codes.
- Use interpersonal skills to effectively communicate QA/QC requirements and objectives between supervision and lead personnel.
- Assure product meets and/or exceeds standards and specifications.
- Perform NDE inspection and documentation. (as qualified)
- Assist Inspection Manager / Leads person and QA/QC personnel as needed.
- Maintain documentation.
- Work at a pace sufficient to obtain quality and quantity of inspection/testing, consistent with operational requirements.
- Available to accommodate a flexible work schedule.
- Perform other tasks and duties as assigned by Manager.

- As needed the employee should have sufficient education, training and experience to ensure qualification in inspection methods, which are being employed.
- Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out detailed but uninvolved written or oral instructions.
- Ability to deal with problems involving a few concrete variables in standardized situations
- Ability to add, subtract, multiply and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions and decimals.
- Ability to compute rate, ratio, percent and to draw and interpret bar graphs.

- Hold enough current certifications to score a minimum of 9 points on the NW Pipe QA Certification Rating Card.
 - 0– 9 points = D
 - 9 – 15 points = C
 - 16 – 24 points = B
 - 25+ points = A

PHYSICAL DEMANDS/WORK ENVIRONMENT:

- The environmental conditions for this position include inclement indoor/outdoor extremes of cold, heat, dust, wind and various forms of precipitation.
- Walking, moving around and or standing eight (8) hours or more per day.
- Recurring climbing and descending of stairs or stepladders throughout the day to perform work. Work for this position may be performed at an elevated station.
- A limited amount of sitting/kneeling may be required for this position.
- There is repetitive hand-wrist, elbow and shoulder motion required for this position for approximately eight (8) hours or more during the workday.
- Lifting and or retrieving items of 0-50 pounds without assistance; 50-100 pounds with assistance and 100+ pounds with mechanical assistance.
- In the course of a normal day additional physical activities include bending, stooping, squatting, crawling, pushing, pulling, twisting, reaching, performing work in awkward positions and climbing ladders.
- Employees in this position are exposed to a wide range of varying degree of moderate to excessive noise levels.
- Sight must be within normal ranges to determine that machines are running properly. Specific vision abilities also include close, distance, color, peripheral, depth and the ability to adjust and focus.
- Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
