SUMMARY OF JOB PURPOSE:

The C&L Operator (Ringer) is primarily responsible for prepping pipe and cement finishing of pipe in the coating and lining department. Under ongoing supervision, installs and removes rings from product, applies cement patch, load and unload pipe, mixes raw materials, grind product, and modify product.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Helps load materials and equipment safely and efficiently on vehicles.
- Helps unloads materials and equipment safely and efficiently.
- Helps move product, materials and equipment safely.
- Installs and removes rings on pipe.
- Ensures rings are inspected and maintained properly.
- Prepares vehicles and equipment for loads.
- Mixes cement and prepares material for patchwork.
- Performs cement labor as needed by lead person and/or supervisor.
- Ensures ISO procedures are performed correctly.
- Follows all safety and company policies / procedures and promotes a safe culture
- Prepares pipe for coating.
- Finish cement.
- Counts and marks all materials.
- Inspect pipe before and after pipe is coated and or lined.
- Performs other duties as needed by the supervisor.

JOB SCOPE:

This position provides support to the Shipping Supervisor and Lead in the preparation, application and finishing of cement lined steel pipe.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the

- Must be able to operate a guniting machine/hose.
- Must be skilled in cement finishing.
- Reading gauges and watching guides.
- Ability to read drawings to determine correct coating/lining to be applied to pipe.
- Must be able to read tape measure accurately.
- Ability to obtain and maintain forklift certification if required.
- Able to operate skip loader/grader equipment.
- Ability to use hand held radios for communicating.

WORK HOURS / SHIFT

- Work hours vary or change based on operational needs.
- Must be able to work on Saturdays and overtime as required.

EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE

- High school diploma or general education degree (GED) and one to two years related experience and/or training: or equivalent combination of education and experience.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS/WORK ENVIRONMENT:

- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand; use hands to touch; reach with hands and arms; and talk or hear.
- The employee frequently is required to walk and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl.
- The employee is occasionally required to sit, climb or balance, and taste or smell.
